Red Ribbon Week at Dailard



The Red Ribbon Campaign is an annual alcohol, tobacco, other drugs, and violence prevention awareness campaign observed nationally each October since 1988. It is the oldest and largest drug prevention program, and millions of students participate each year. The 2014 Red Ribbon Week runs from October 23 through October 31, and Dailard students have special Spirit Week events from Monday the 27th to Thursday the 30th.
